1. Meeting opened and called to order at 7:01 PM by Dana McIntyre.
2. **Presentation by Adrian Eaton from Tafeli Gourmet Cookies** - Tafeli is a Swedish term for "sweet"; it is a local business started two years ago that offers fresh, traditional cookies. They started a fundraising option last fall and would like to offer that to Ronald Harvey School. They are part of Healthy Hunger. No delivery fee, no GST, 1 box of cookies sells for \$20. Normally, fundraiser will raise \$8 per box and Tafeli will offer \$9 per box as his children are a part of our school. For printing, they partner with Clear Copy. Clear Copy will print a "temperature gauge" poster. Also indicated that they do incentives for fundraising and do social media ads. Need 8-10 business days lead time for orders.
2. Approval of agenda by Natasha, seconded by Krista.
3. Approval of minutes by Natasha, seconded by Krista.
4. No correspondence to circulate.
4. **Fundraising Committee New Volunteers? and/or New Fundraisers?:**
  - **Tafeli Gourmet Cookies** - discussion about whether cookie fundraiser could replace the Basket Raffle at Christmas.
    - *Motion: Dana put forth a motion to go forward with the Tafeli Gourmet Cookies in December. All approved*
    - *Motion: Dana put forth a motion to cancel the Basket Raffle Fundraiser this year. All approved.*
    - Dana will inform Adrian Eaton about fundraiser plans.
  - **Halloween Fun Night** (6:30-8:30 PM) - Planned for October 25.
    - Susan Rankin mentioned that Bellerose helpers are available again.
    - *Motion: Dana put forth a motion to cover the cost of the crafts \$100 that Bellerose helpers will purchase. All approved.*
    - Natasha to purchase for Snack Shack and prizes.
    - *Motion: Dana put forth a motion to cover the cost of the \$150 (prizes) and \$300 (Snack Shack, Bake Sale). All approved*
    - Decorating will begin on Thursday, Oct 10 - come one, come all!
    - Krista mentioned that Zoo to You is unavailable but Krista has found a potential alternate.
  - **Food Basket in Office** - Natasha met with Save on Foods and they will provide \$25 gift card per month. Save Food asked for a letter to support. Natasha filled the basket; fresh fruit going a bit slower than other choices but food basket is being used.
  - **Hot Lunch** - first hot lunch is on Thursday.
  - **Popcorn Day** - On the first popcorn day there was a shortage of popcorn. They plan to limit popcorn bags to 2 bags per student. \$1 per bag.
  - **Other:**
    - Additional garbage cans - a couple of extra cans added by the City until end of October. The school is responsible for providing permanent cans.
    - Follow-up on playground equipment confirmed that it is with the Facilities Department. Mrs. Anderson reported that the equipment will be moved back into the playground as soon as feasible.
    - Dana mentioned that some parents have suggested a different night for the meetings. *Motion: Dan put forth a motion to move meetings to the 3rd Monday of the month. All approved.*
    - Natasha mentioned that Cobbs has a fundraiser with us, however; Gail noted that we did not receive any funds from them. Gail is also not sure if Boston Pizza needs to be setup again. Dana will follow-up.
